



## Polar Code course Basic and Advanced

We offer basic and advanced Polar Code courses for Officers and operators. The course covers all training requirements in the IMO Polar Code, which will be mandatory as of 1 January 2017.

Polar Code course will be in Kalmar, Sweden. It is a cooperation with the Linnæus University and with Viking Supply Ships and Viking Ice Consultancy.

Next Polar Code Basic course will be in Week 17 and a combined Polar Code Basic and Advanced will be in week 21.

Week 17: Polar Code Basic course start at 12:00 on 25<sup>th</sup> of April and end at 12:00 on 27<sup>th</sup> of April

Week 21: Polar Code Basic course start at 12:00 on 23<sup>th</sup> of May and end at 12:00 on 25<sup>th</sup> of May

Week 21: Polar Code Advanced course start at 13:00 on 25<sup>th</sup> of May and end at 13:00 on 27<sup>th</sup> of May
